

DC++ : Installing / Setting up : Alternative hublists?

One of the benefits of using DC++ is the ability to switch the hublist that is downloaded. To start out, [Hublist.org](http://www.hublist.org) is a great site with a large list of hublists. To use another hublist, open up File -> Settings. Click on the Download tab and then replace the public hub list URL at the bottom.
